WHAT IS YOUR REALITY?

If you're launching a new student ministry in your country, start by getting a glimpse of your reality.

- Since you share target groups, how does the Youth department work in your country? Is it possible to establish a partnership, i.e., work together?
- Where do most students live?
- What are the needs of students in your country?
 - Loneliness?
 - Faith crisis?
 - Practical needs: housing, grocery shopping, etc.
 - What are students going through?



2 TYPES OF MODEL IN EUROPE

Event-based

- Usually happens when AMiCUS leader works as a volunteer (not full-time, has their own job).
- A few events in the year.
- Contact with students few times in a year.
- Little presence on campus.
- Less impact on students.

e.g.: Spain (AEGUAE)

Ministry-based

- Works when the leader is employed a specific amount of time.
- Weekly events and activities; things are happening on a regular basis.
- Constant contact with students.
- Strong presence on campus.
- Greater impact on students.

e.g.: Czech Republic (INRIroad) and Romania (AMiCUS)



IDEAS

- **Identify students** in your country. WHO do you want to reach? How many? Where? How are they connected? Learn what the needs of students are (survey, one-to-one interviews, focus group) in each of the five key areas of AMiCUS (Connect. Think. Encounter Jesus. Be. Act.)
- Focus on creating student-friendly churches in cities with students
 - REACH handbook.
 - Churches should: Be helpful in practical ways, provide a home away from home, promote spiritual nurture, provide lifestyle challenges, involve students in evangelism.
- Organize national and regional events
 - Inspiring event at beginning of school year to: remind students they are not alone, deal with specific challenges and questions they face at university, connect with other students, etc.

 - Faith and science focus. Geoscience Research Institute (GRI) (Noemí Durán) can be helpful. Public debates at university (e.g. a believer and a non-believer addressing certain topics)





IDEAS

- Help organize local chapters
 - Romania)
 - Train students to lead their own local student groups
- Facilitate useful materials
 - Create your own materials for students (e.g. handbook, podcasts, online meetings, social media initiatives, etc.)
 - Translate existing materials

AMICUS COMMITTEE

- At the EUD level, the AMICUS Committee meets once a year to further develop and grow the AMICUS ministry in Europe.
- The AMICUS Committee is made up of all the AMICUS leaders of the EUD Unions.



EUD EVENTS

- The AMiCUS Congress is an event focused on students. It takes place every 3-4 years.



• This is a great opportunity to connect with other European students and go deeper into different topics.
